All of the client fisheries are based in EU Member States and are therefore subject to all of the CFP control regulations, including Council Regulations 1224/2009, 1139/2016 and 1241/2019. The parties, or categories of parties, that are entitled to use this certificate to enter fish from the certified fishery into certified chains of custody:

Vessels engaged in industrial fishing in the Baltic Sea are only permitted to land their catches at ports that have been designated by the national authorities. The national authorities have established catch sampling programmes at these ports to ensure that information is gathered about catch composition.

The eligible (designated) ports in each UoA are listed in tables below. Note that vessels from some UoAs may land to ports within other UoA areas, but only to the designated ports listed.

Germany

In Germany, herring and sprats can be landed in small quantities (<5t) at any port; landings of >5t must be made at designated ports where there are appropriate facilities to handle the catch and allow for inspections. Information is provided to fishermen by the State (Länder) fishery enforcement body describing the regulations relevant to each port, along with a satellite map showing the location of the fish quay in the port.
